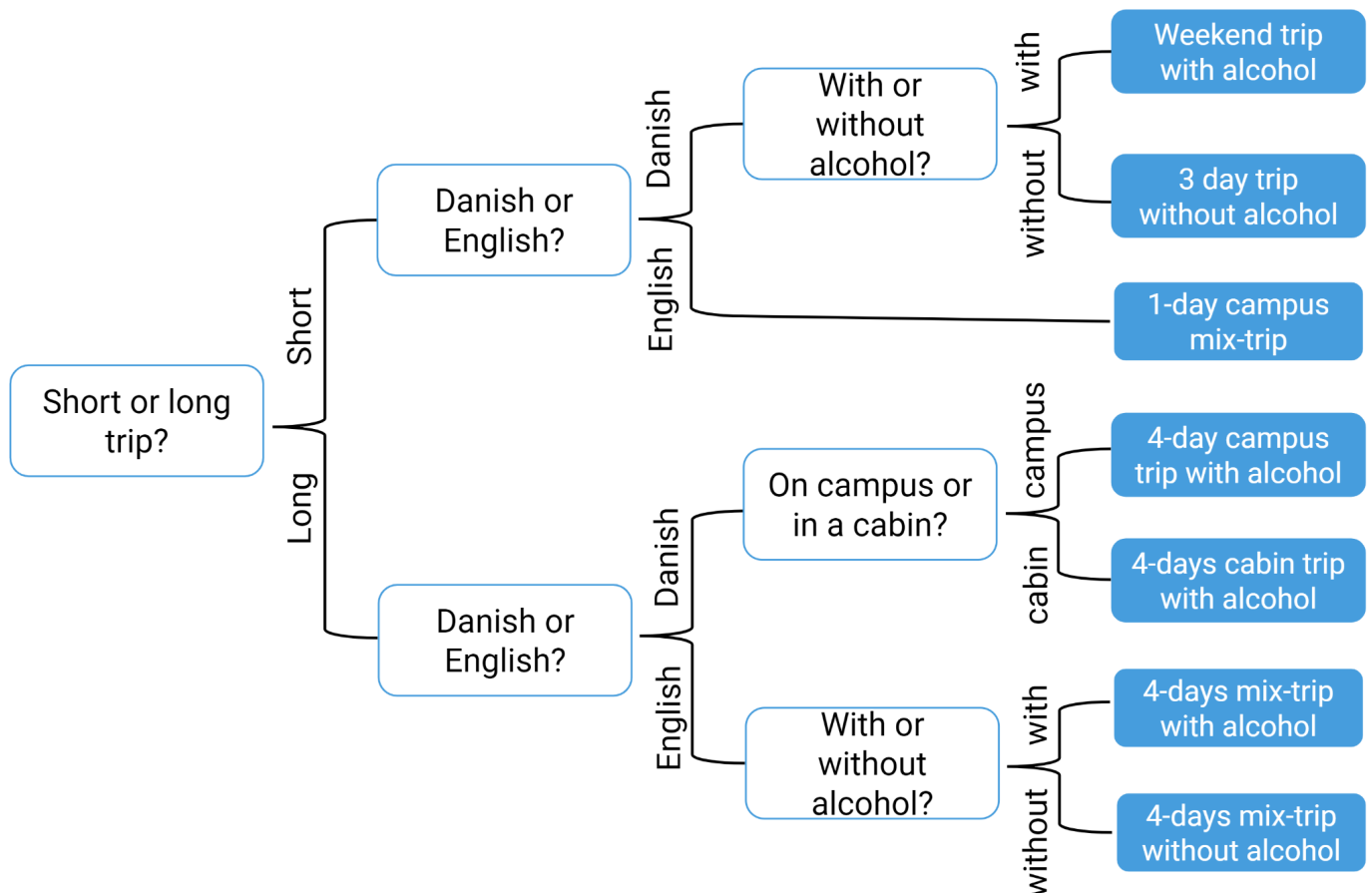
## First lecture day
